- I can write a three-line haiku.
- I can write a five-syllable first line, a seven-syllable second line and a five-syllable third line.
- I can use precise, evocative vocabulary that makes it easy for the reader to imagine the subject.
- I can use sensory descriptions.
- I can use a thesaurus to choose appropriate synonyms.
- I can focus on a single image or moment in time.
- I can write a haiku that flows smoothly when I read it aloud.
- I can decide whether or not a title is needed.
- I can choose appropriate punctuation, deciding whether to start each line with a capital letter and end each line with punctuation.
