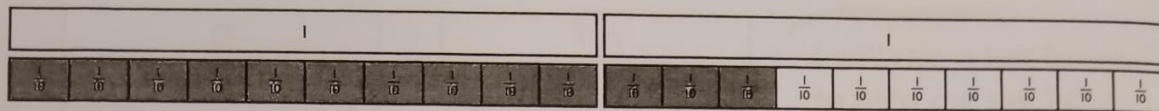

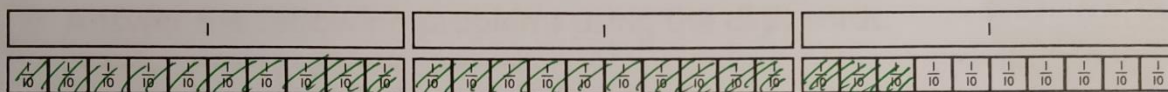

a) What number is shaded above?

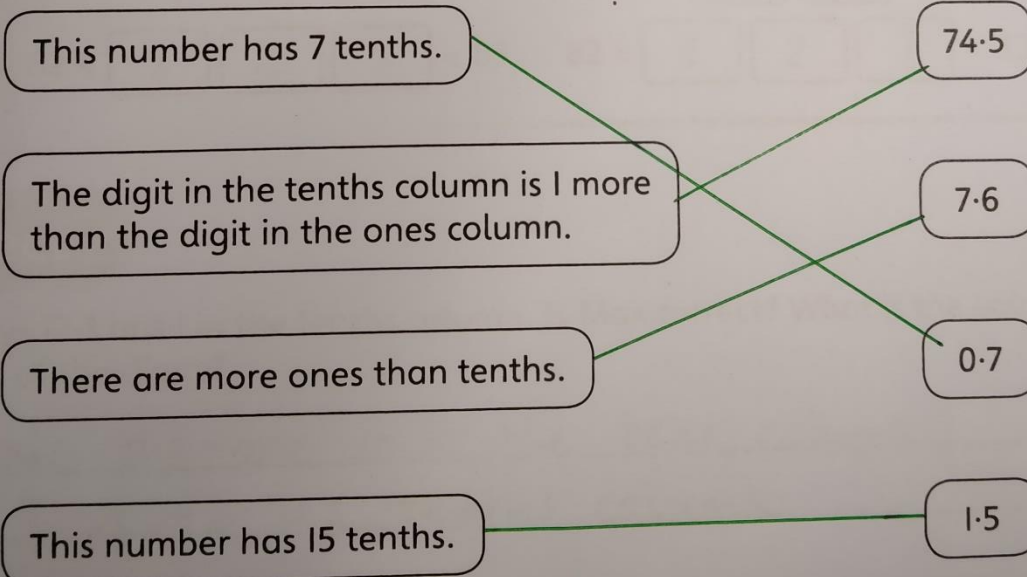
The shaded parts represent $\frac{13}{10}$ or 1.3 .

b) Shade the following fraction strip to show 2.3.

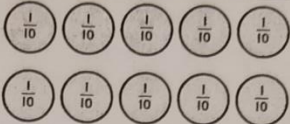

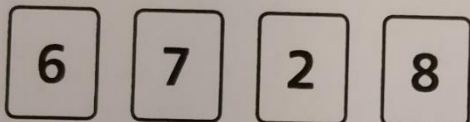
