Here are some example questions that you may like to include on your quiz

- Africa is the worlds ----- continent
- How did the Kingdom of Aksum, The Kingdom of Benin and Mali Empire gain great power?
- From 1441 onwards, enslaved African people were transported to Portugal and bought, sold and treated like cattle. This form of enslavement became known as what?
- African tribes sold enslaved people from central Africa to Europe in exchange for what?
- In 1492, who discovered Hispaniola?
- How many journeys were there in the Triangular slave trade?
- What did many die from when onboard the slave ships?
- When was the Slavery Abolition Act passed?
- After the Berlin West Africa Conference. How many colonies was Africa divided into?
- What year was the Race Relations Act passed?
